

# Notice of Development in Progress

Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997  
Town and Country Planning (Development Management Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 2013 -  
Regulation 41

*(Please read and follow accompanying Notes for Guidance below when completing this notice)*

For all National and Major developments and developments specified in Schedule 3 (development which may impact over a wider area) of the Development Management Procedure (Scotland) Regulations 2013 (DMR), there is a legal requirement on the developer to display a notice or notices at their expense in the form in Schedule 7 to the DMR (see template below) in a prominent place at or in the vicinity of the site of the development; readily visible to the public; and printed on durable material. It is the responsibility of the person carrying out the development to ensure compliance with these requirement. It may constitute a breach of control not to display such a Notice and planning enforcement action may follow.

The purpose of the Notice is to provide the public with information:

- about the permission, reducing the potential number of enquiries concerning the development of the site
- as to where further details of the permission can be obtained
- as to where further enquiries may be made
