- Build self-esteem and self confidence
- Develop the ability to manage personal and social relationships
- Create learning and develop new skills
- Encourage positive group atmospheres
- Build the capacity of young people to consider risk, make reasoned decisions and take control
- Develop a 'world view' which widens horizons and invites social commitment

## IT HAS THREE ESSENTIAL AND DEFINITIVE FEATURES:

- Young people choose to take part
- The work must build from where young people are
- Youth Work recognises the young person and youth worker as partners in the learning process

- Community Based Youth Work Opportunities: Delivery of local youth work groups, projects, and opportunities in evenings and weekends with our most vulnerable and marginalised young people and support to young people's health and wellbeing.
- Youth Work in Schools: Delivery of accredited Qualifications and Youth Awards in schools and low-level mental health support through Youth Information Workers.
- Youth Participation and Volunteering: Opportunities for young people to become involved in decision making through projects inc. Regional Youth Council, Champions Board and Young Volunteers.
- Wider Achievement: Creating opportunities for young people to achieve accredited Youth Awards inc. Duke of Edinburgh's Award, Youth Achievement, John Muir Awards.
- Collaboration With Third Sector Youth Work: Training, advice and support to Third Sector partners and practitioner torums.
