# Remuneration

Under the Local Governance (Scotland) Act 2004 (Remuneration) Regulations 2007 as amended, there are four levels of remuneration payments for Councillors, depending on the responsibilities of the Councillor. These are the Leader of the Council, Depute Leader, Senior Councillor and Councillor. A Senior Councillor is a Councillor who holds a position of significant responsibility in the Council's Political Management Structure. All other Council other than the Leader of the Council and the Convenor will receive the basic remuneration as prescribed by the Regulations. Remuneration is subject to income tax and national insurance deductions.

## Travel and Subsistence

These expenses are paid at rates determined by Regulation. Councillors may claim costs incurred when travelling on approved duties. The total amount of these payments will vary from Councillor to Councillor, depending on a number of factors. These factors include the distance that they live from Council Headquarters (which affects the amount of travelling required to attend the meetings of the Council), the area covered by their Ward and whether they represent the Council on external bodies such as COSLA.

Katie Hagmann and Gail Macgregor both have national roles within COSLA.

COSLA has an agreement with all Scottish Councils that the Council concerned will bear the first £2,500 of any expenses in relation to the attendance of reps to COSLA meetings and that COSLA will reimburse any costs in excess of that. Car expenses met directly by Council represent the capital and running costs of pool cars used by Councillors that equates to an average of 30p per mile.

#### Telephone and ICT Expenses

The Council provides elected members with mobiles and broadband facilities to enable them to carry out Council business. Such costs are met directly by the Council but require to be published as a cost to the Councillor in the above table.

### Provost Civic Allowance

This allowance is paid to offset expenditure by the Provost carrying out Civic duties. The maximum yearly allowance prescribed by Regulation for Dumfries and Galloway Council is £3,000.

#### New Council and appointment of Leaders and Senior Councillors

Scottish Council Elections concluded on the 8 May 2022 which brought about a new Council. Elected Members listed at the bottom of the above table resigned or were not re-elected. As the appointment to roles within the Council Administration was subject to a number of changes during the financial year the specific roles undertaken by Councillors during the year has not been reflected within the above table . Details on the movements during the year can be found on the Council's website under Full Council.

#### Additional Payments

Archie Dryburgh received a payment of £6,050 within 2022/23 for their role as APSE Chair (Association for Public Service Excellence). Dumfries and Galloway Council have been reimbursed for these costs.
