A questionnaire to gather views was also circulated via social media and professional networks over the same period.</p> <p>10,000 Voices Consultation provided the group with a steer on the issues that affect young people across Dumfries and Galloway, and what role Youth Work has in providing a response to these issues, and how work can be targeted towards alleviating these.</p>
