Family Learning: Help all families with knowledge that will support learning wherever this takes place.



Staff will support parents/Carers to take part in their children's learning in school, and outside of school, to help your child reach their potential.

Decision Making: Parents/Carers being involved in decisions.



We will include parents in decisions on how the school works with parents and pupils. We will involve the people and organisations that might be affected or benefit.

Developing parent leaders and representatives like the Parent Council is an example of this.

Collaborating with the Community: Work with local community partners to support the families and the school.



The school will look to find people who can give resources and services locally that will help the school, children and families with learning and teaching.
