Dumfries and Galloway Cultural Partnership Code of Conduct

As at 8 January 2025

Members of the Dumfries and Galloway Cultural Partnership (DGCP), including paid officers and members of its Thematic Groups, shall subscribe to and comply with the Code of Conduct, as laid out below:

- Members have a responsibility to promote and support the delivery of the Cultural Strategy for Dumfries and Galloway
- When attending any meeting or event on behalf of the DGCP, members will represent the collective views of the group, and not their personal opinions
- Members of the group will maintain a neutral stance on political matters while representing the DGCP in any capacity
- Members must not disclose or make any other use of confidential information to which they have access other than for a proper purpose relating to the performance of services for the DGCP
- Members must disclose any interest which they may have (or might be seen to have) when they are asked to provide service as a DGCP member.
 Partners must also disclose any interest that could otherwise prejudice any service they are asked to perform
- Members must ensure mutual trust and respect at all times and that differences in opinion are respected
- There is a visible commitment from members to promote equality and diversity, Fair Work, and environmental sustainability
