DISCRETIONARY GRANTS FOR FINANCIAL YEAR 2017/18

I am pleased to advise your Community Council that applications may be submitted for Community Council discretionary grants for the financial year 2017/18 (1 April 2017 to 31 March 2018).

I attach a short Annual Monitoring Form which asks how your Community Council spent its discretionary grant for last financial year (2016/17). The form explains what your Community Council needs to do in order to be eligible for a discretionary grant. Your grant will be considered on receipt of the completed form and the following:

- BACS form, if any change since last year (enclosure 1);

In addition, minutes of all Community Councils should be submitted to Dumfries & Galloway Council per the timescales as detailed in section 12.5b of the Scheme of Establishment of Community Councils. The email address for submitting minutes is community.councils@dumgal.gov.uk. Community Councils who do not submit their minutes within the timescale may not receive their grant until these minutes are being received on a regular monthly basis.

Can I please also request that you inform Dumfries and Galloway Council of any changes to new members, existing members, co-opted members and office bearers as soon as possible as detailed in the "Checklist of Good Practice" which I have attached for your information.
