History of Flooding in Newton Stewart

Newton Stewart has suffered from repeated flooding in the past, including the following major recent events:

- November 2012: Major flood event;
- December 2013: Peak flow of 290m³/s in the town; and
- December 2015: Similar magnitude to 2012 event
