

#### Q1 What area is your main work location?





### Q2 How frequently do you use public toilets operated by Dumfries and Galloway Council?






## Q4 Nithsdale - What public toilet facilities have you used in the past year? (tick all that apply)

## Q5 Stewartry - What public toilet facilities have you used in the past year? (tick all that apply)






### Q12 When at work do you use other Council Buildings to use their toilet? eg leisure centres, libraries

#### Q13 If you use other Council Buildings (please tick all that apply)






# Q14 When at work do you use other public places to use their toilets? eg hospitals, cafes

#### Q15 If you use other non-public toilets (please tick all that apply)






