GYRODACTYLUS SALARIS DECLARATION

Gyrodactylus salaris is an extremely dangerous parasite and we are taking the most careful steps to ensure it does not enter the Dumfries Common Good Fishings. As such, in conjunction with the Nith District Salmon Fishery Board, we are adopting rigorous biosecurity procedures which we are sure you will support.

If this parasite enters the River Nith Catchment it means the absolute end of our Salmon. Therefore you are required to sign one of the declarations below before purchasing a permit.

Note: you will be unable to purchase a permit if you are unable to satisfy the conditions of either declaration.

A. I declare that my fishing equipment **has** been used outside the United Kingdom in the 7 days prior to my commencement of fishing at River Nith (Dumfries Common Good Fishings) on _____ (insert date) and that it has been properly sterilised adopting one of the following methods (please tick one of the following):

Method A: <i>Drying to a minimum of 20°C for at least 2 days</i>	
Method B: Heating to above 60°C for at least one hour
