### Paper

- ✓ Newspapers and magazines
- ✓ Catalogues and directories
- ✓ Letters and junk mail
- ✓ Envelopes (including windows)
- ✓ Office and shredded paper
- ✓ Paperback books (or donate to charity if possible)

### Card and cardboard

- ✓ Cereal boxes
- ✓ Cardboard packaging
- ✓ Corrugated cardboard boxes
- ✓ Glitter free greetings cards
- ✓ Toilet and kitchen roll tubes
- ✓ Cardboard egg boxes

Please remove packing tape from cardboard boxes and plastic covers from magazines before recycling them - you do not need to remove the staples.

## No

- ✗ Tissues or napkins
- ✗ Padded envelopes
- ✗ Kitchen towels
- ✗ Wet paper or cardboard
- ✗ Wallpaper
- ✗ Paper or cardboard contaminated with food - for example, takeaway pizza boxes
- ✗ Disposable coffee cups
- ✗ Hardback books (donate to charity if possible)

Please don't put recycling in plastic bags

### Plastics

#### Rinsed and squashed

- ✓ Food and drinks bottles
- ✓ Toiletry bottles
- ✓ Tablet and medicine bottles
- ✓ Pots, tubs and trays (all colours)
- ✓ Yoghurt pots and margarine tubs
- ✓ Plastic bottle lids and tops

### Metals

#### Empty and rinsed

- ✓ Tins
- ✓ Drinks cans
- ✓ Empty aerosols
- ✓ Foil trays
- ✓ Clean aluminium foil
- ✓ Chocolate and biscuit tins
- ✓ Metal lids and caps

### Cartons

#### Rinsed and squashed

- ✓ Food and drink cartons

## No

- ✗ Glass
- ✗ Plastic bags, liners or cling film
- ✗ Bubble wrap
- ✗ Polystyrene
- ✗ Plant pots
- ✗ Biscuit or sweet wrappers
- ✗ Plastic wrappers or netting
- ✗ Crisp bags
- ✗ Plastic cups or straws
- ✗ Pet food pouches
- ✗ Oil and paint cans
- ✗ Small or large electrical items
- ✗ Batteries or wire
- ✗ Cutlery
- ✗ Metal pots, pans or trays
