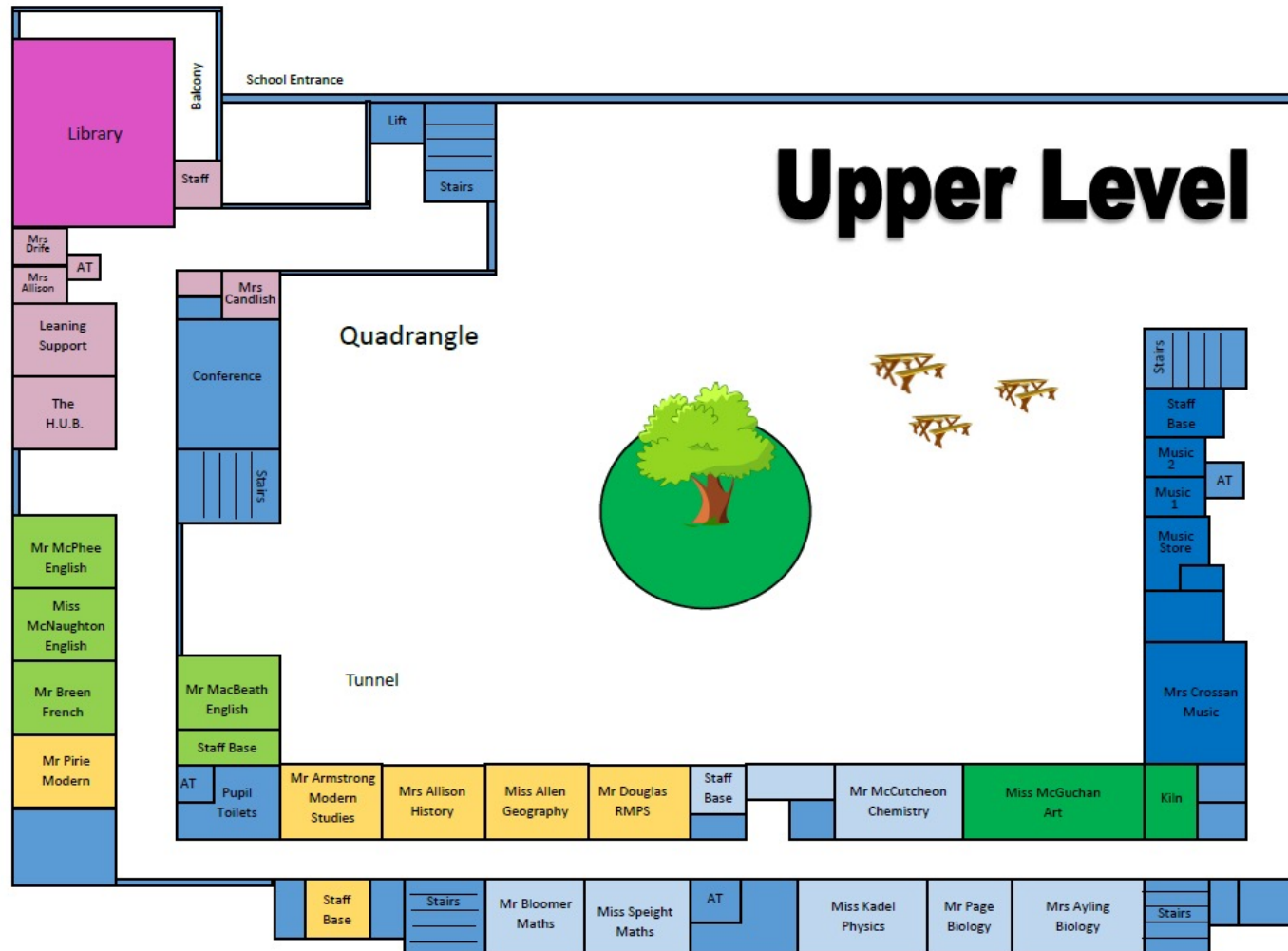

- Our S1 pupils get to study lots of subjects across the week. This shows you an example of what your week could look like.



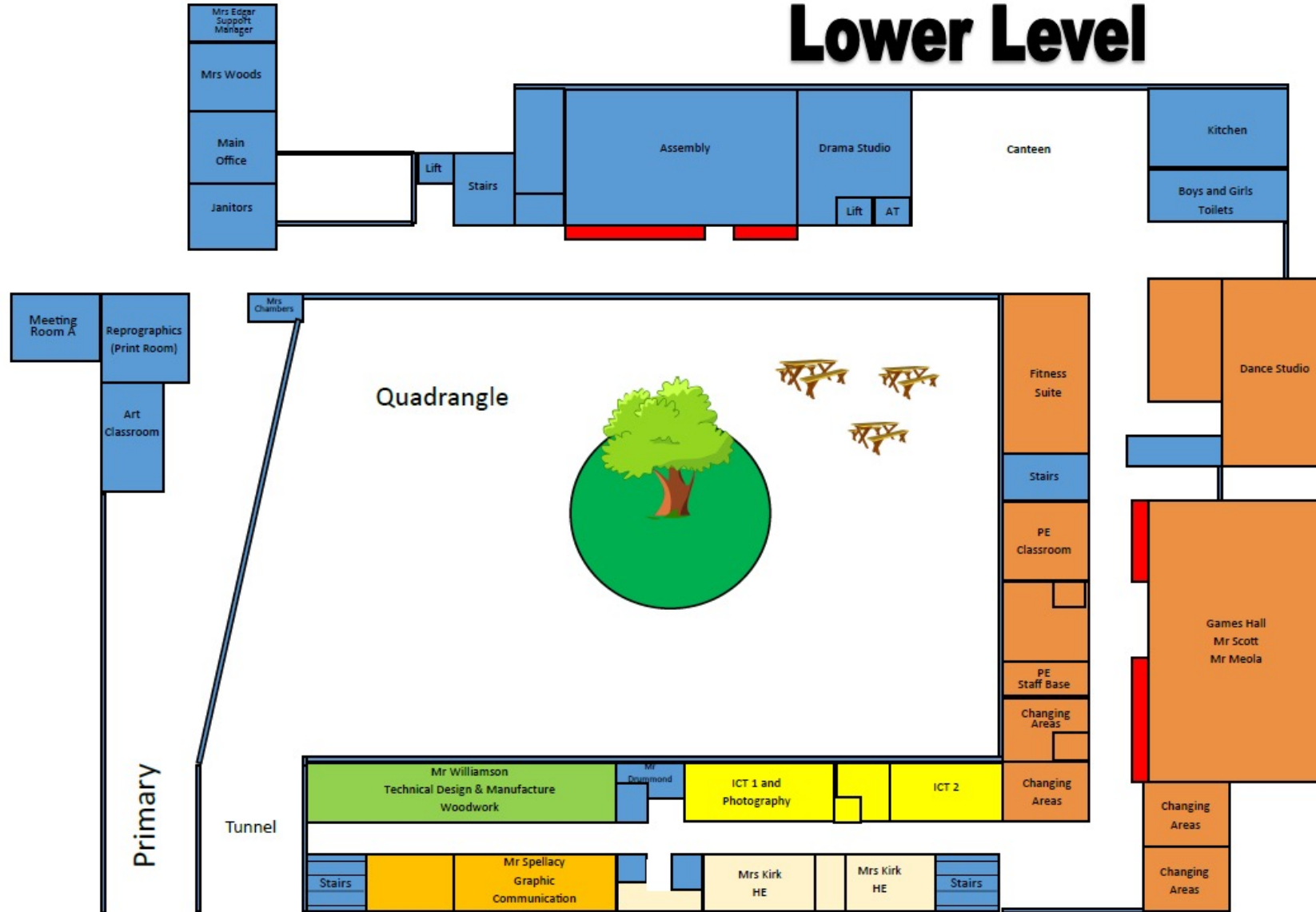
FINDING YOUR WAY ABOUT OUR BEAUTIFUL SCHOOL...

Lower Level

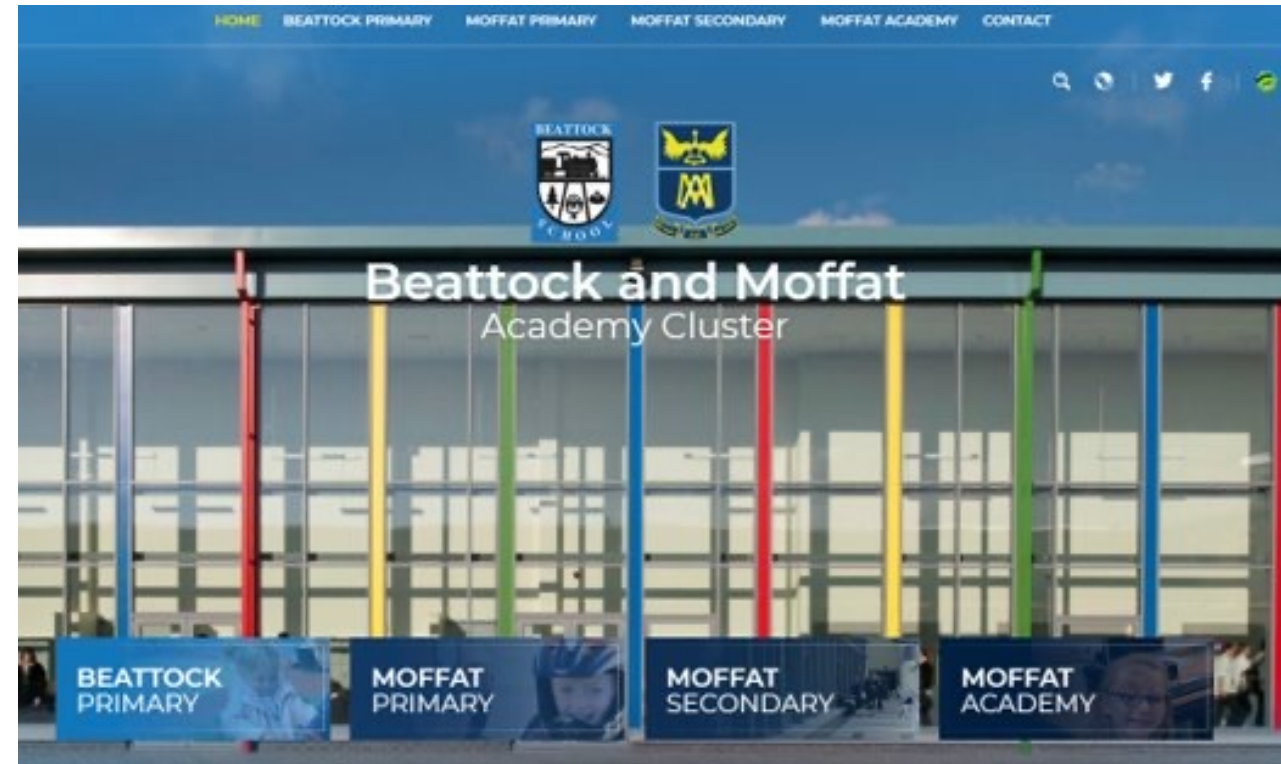


WEBSITE AND APP

PUPIL SUPPORT



- In the secondary, part of my job is to lead the Pupil Support Department. All the teachers in the school are there for you to speak to but sometimes you may want to speak to one of us too. Pupil Support staff have special training in lots of different areas to help support pupils with a variety of things.
- Pupil Support can help you with all sorts of things about school and about yourself.
- If you have any worries or questions, we are here for you.
- In addition to me there are three Pupil Support staff and one Learning Support. Mrs Ayling is in charge of S1, Mrs Drife is in charge of S2 and S3, and Mrs Allison is in charge of S4/5/6. Mrs Orr is in charge of Learning Support.
- You will find us near the secondary library in our offices or in our classrooms (which you will soon get to know).
- I will introduce you all to Mrs Ayling on your first day so you know who she is and where you can find her! ☺





MRS AYLING . . .

- Mrs Ayling is Pupil Support for S1.
- She also teaches Biology.
- This is the first port of call for parents or carers, as well as you, if you have any worries or questions.

SAFEGUARDING AND CHILD PROTECTION...

- I (Mrs Candlish) am the Depute Head for GIRFEC and Pupil Support. I am also the Child Protection Officer for our Secondary school. Basically this means if any of you (or your parents or carers) have any concerns about the welfare or safety of our young people/your friends or yourself then you should let me know.
- If I am not available Mrs Woods our Head Teacher can also help.
- If she is not available then any member of the Pupil Support staff, or any teacher, can help.
- There is always someone to speak to. 😊

MRS ORR....

- Mrs Orr is the Principal Teacher of Learning Support.
- She helps pupils with all sorts of things regards their learning.
- The Primary will pass any relevant information on to Mrs Orr regards support in the primary.
- If parents or carers have any concerns regards barriers to learners she will be able to talk things through with them and seek supports.



BREAKS & LUNCHES

- At breaktime you can buy a snack from the canteen or bring your own. You can sit in the canteen or go out to play in the playground.
- Yes...S1 are allowed out of the school normally for lunch if they wish...but on the first day you will all stay in so we can check in on you all and answer any questions you might have. 😊
- Like in Primary school the canteen has an array of hot and cold meals for you. We will be there to help you all get what you need. Remember your lunch money or Young Scott Card.
- If you wish to bring a packed lunch you are more than welcome to do so.
- You can get a school meal for around £2.



EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES AND LUNCH CLUBS...



- We have lots of extra-curricular activities on offer throughout the year and we would encourage you all to get involved in these.
- A full timetable of clubs etc will be issued to you when we know what is on offer and when.
