Reduced cost Taxi travel for people resident in Dumfries and Galloway



Do I qualify?

The Taxicard is available to residents of Dumfries and Galloway who are:-

- 1. registered blind
- 2. in receipt of the higher rate mobility element of Disability Living Allowance or PIP Mobility Component Standard or Enhanced Rate
- 3. in receipt of War Pensioner Mobility Supplement
- 4. over the age of 60 and have a severe restriction of mobility

What concession do I get?

An annual subsidy of £100 towards the cost of taxi journeys. You may make journeys anywhere in Dumfries and Galloway and to destinations beyond, provided your journey either starts or finishes in Dumfries and Galloway.

What restrictions are there?

There are no time restrictions; you may use your Taxicard at any time of the day and on any day of the week.

How much does it cost?

Your Taxicard will cost just £2.

How does it work?

You will get a photo ID Taxicard but you will need to decide how you want to receive your £100 credit:

Option 1 – Voucher (50 vouchers of £2)

- Book your journey with any participating taxi company (apart from McLeans Taxis)
- At the end of the journey present your Taxicard ID and 1 or more vouchers in exchange for a fare reduction
- The drivers will record the journey

OR

Option 2 - Card (McLeans taxis only - based Stranraer, Newton Stewart & Dumfries)

- Book your journey with McLeans
- At the end of the journey present your Taxicard ID and your McLeans card and tell the driver how much you want deducted from the fare.

How do I apply?

You should take the completed form, photograph, documentary evidence and payment to one of the Customer Services Centres/Social Work Services offices listed below. Examples of documentary evidence are, correspondence from the DWP, Disability Living Allowance Book, PIP Evidence Letter, Letter from GP confirming severe restriction of mobility (There may be a charge from your GP when requesting a letter).
